

## FRESH OFF ITS U.S. LAUNCH, THE AWARD-WINNING DRAMA BLACKSTONE RETURNS TO APTN FOR SEASON FOUR

**Toronto. Oct. 20, 2014** – *Blackstone*, the critically acclaimed hit drama recently highlighted in the *New York Times*, returns to APTN for season four with eight new episodes. Winner of 28 television awards, *Blackstone* is an authentic drama that explores the raw and real dynamics of family, power and politics on a First Nation reserve. This season, *Blackstone* delves into the often taboo topic of residential schools – and their lasting effect that reverberates in communities today, the high number of Aboriginals in prison, and the plight of missing Aboriginal women. Actors Jennifer Podemski and Glen Gould join the all-star ensemble. Produced by **Prairie Dog Film + Television**, *Blackstone* season four airs **Tuesdays at 10 p.m. starting Nov. 11 on APTN** (for exact regional times, see below).

"I am a student of life and an observer of human nature and ultimately *Blackstone* is about people," says Ron E. Scott, executive producer, writer & director. "It's not unlike series that have inspired me through the years like *Six Feet Under* or *The Sopranos*, where viewers follow characters who live their lives under the circumstances handed to them. Whether it's a funeral home or a mob family or a reserve, every situation is more complicated than what society sees on the surface. That's why it is so fascinating to experience the long form narrative of serialized television, where the journey of the characters is relatable, complex and interconnected."

The fourth season picks up on *Blackstone* as the community tries to rebuild after the reserve was set on fire. Manipulative and tormented Andy Fraser (Eric Schweig of *Longmire, Maïna, The Last of the Mohicans*) faces his demons in the remand prison while trying to elude a murder charge. Leona Stoney (Carmen Moore of *Arctic Air, Supernatural, Godiva's*) searches for two missing youth when rumors arise they may be involved in an underground human trafficking circle in the city. Gail Stoney (Michelle Thrush of *Jimmy P., Hell on Wheels, Fargo*) continues to be haunted by the stabbing of Darrien, the death of her child, and past addictions. Actress Jennifer Podemski (*Empire of Dirt, Jimmy P., Degrassi*) joins the cast as a psychologist, Dr. Crowshoe, specializing in post-traumatic stress disorder. Glen Gould (*Mohawk Girls, Rhymes for Young Ghouls*) plays estranged brother to Leona and Gail, Smokey Stoney.

In addition to the previously mentioned, a noteworthy ensemble cast returns this season including Nathaniel Arcand (*Heartland, Arctic Air*), Steven Cree Molison (*50 Shades of Grey, Brokeback Mountain*) and Justin Rain (*Defiance, The Twilight Saga: Eclipse*).

Blackstone airs Tuesdays at 10 p.m. ET on APTN HD and APTN East; starting Nov. 11, and repeats Sundays at 10 p.m. ET; Tuesdays at 10 p.m. MT on APTN West starting Nov. 11, and repeats Sundays at 10:00 p.m. MT; Sundays at 10:00 p.m. CT on APTN North starting Nov. 16.

**Blackstone** is produced by Prairie Dog Film + Television, with Ron E. Scott as Executive Producer, Writer & Director and Jesse Szymanski as Co-Executive Producer.
